

Fritz Genther

Fritz Genther, 24, is a Kingston native graduating from Kingston High School in 2019 as a 5-time letter winner and Class President. Fritz was the second player at KHS to make his varsity debut in 8th grade. At KHS, he was a 4 time section 9 champion, a 2x Section 9 Player of the Year, 3x First Team All-Section Selection, 2x 2nd Team All-State and along with these accolades he finished third in school history in hits (94), second in runs (101), second in homeruns (10), third in doubles (28), and 4th in Stolen Bases (35). Fritz also spent parts of three seasons with the hometown Saugerties Stallions of the Perfect Game Collegiate Summer League.

Fritz split his college ball career between Virginia Tech of the Atlantic Coast Conference and UMass Lowell of the America East. Fritz started his first 35 career collegiate games at Virginia Tech where he was named a top 20 ACC Draft Prospect in prior to the 2021 season. Fritz then transferred to UMass Lowell for 3 seasons where he was named to consecutive All-conference teams along with an All-Tournament Selection. Fritz finished his college career surpassing the 200 career hit mark with a total of 211 hits, a career .282 average, 43 doubles, 30 home runs, and 131 RBI.

Most Recently, in 2024 Fritz began his professional career signing a contract with the High Point Rockers of the Atlantic League. After a month in High Point, Fritz was traded to the New Jersey Jackals of the Frontier League. Over his first 51 career professional games, Fritz combined for a .294 average collecting 4 homeruns, 10 doubles, 23 RBI, 11 SB, and only making 4 errors over 158 chances.
