Jamie Heilmann

Jamie (Whittam) Heilmann is a 2012 graduate of Saugerties High School and 2016 graduate of SUNY Oneonta. In her four year career she was the starting second baseman where she helped her team win the conference championship in 2014. During her collegiate career she was a two-time All-SUNYAC selection. Twice during her four years she was selected as female team MVP for SUNY Oneonta (2014, 2016). She had a career batting average of .303, slugging percentage of .408, and on base percentage of .358. She finished her career with school records for SUNY Oneonta's softball program: 2nd in runs scored in a single season at 39, 4th in career runs scored at 101, 4th in single season stolen bases at 19, and 3rd in career stolen bases at 43. Jamie also helped contribute to winning the Division III NCAA most double plays turned per game in 2014. She would later go on to serve as the Assistant Softball Coach for the Oneonta Red Dragons and then for the Cobleskill Fighting Tigers. Jamie currently is the Saugerties JV girls softball coach.
